Writer spins Brit's inner circle

REACHING editors as we speak by way of agent **William Gladstone** is "Stalking Britney: Under Siege With Britney Spears." Author's **Ian Halperin**, journalist, documentarian, book writer.

In the chaos outside Britney's gated Hollywood home — helicopters, wall-to-wall paparazzi hoping for a \$200,000 "money shot" — he claims he got to know Brit's inner circle, who provided perspective on her self-destruction. A former bodyguard knew scenes of nudity, drug use, issues involving her children. There's the tale of her Svengali-like manager, **Osama Lutfi**, who, it's alleged, controlled her, turned her against her parents, and is considered an enabler. There is talk of abusive behavior and a legal restraining order. There are LA court records with mama **Lynne Spears** hurling accusations in a laundry list of misdoings.

This book also opens the paparazzi phenomenon. These professional stalkers who've made stars' lives hell, allowing them no privacy, turning them into prisoners of their own fame. It is said members of street gangs treat the trade in Brit photos as a "criminal racket." One photographer quit his agency, claiming, "The Britney story is no longer about Britney. It's the media circus surrounding her. It's not journalism. Sooner or later, someone's going to get killed. Possibly Britney herself."

But the author explores a side the Hol-

lywood establishment and mainstream media don't acknowledge. For instance, how paparazzi always know where Britney will be on a given evening and how come a huge media horde awaits when she makes an unscheduled appearance at some club? Explains one: "She calls and tells us. She craves attention." Celebrity photo agencies confirm they receive calls alerting them to her plans for the evening. "She's not the only one," another shooter tells Halperin. "Paris Hilton, Lindsay Lohan, Courtney Love, plenty of others, desperate to remain in the spotlight, do the same thing. They all have our cell numbers. Hollywood publicists earn their salary ringing us up and telling us where their client will be that night. Without them, we'd be out of business."

Britney's paparazzi closeness was underscored last year when she began a romance with one of them. **Adnan Ghalib** reveals what he claims went on that night when Spears' parents engineered what he calls a coup, forcing him out of her life and committing her to an institution, fol-

lowed by her father taking legal control over her affairs.

Among the other highlights:

Britney's inner circle talks about the subject of suicide.

A former dealer, delivering to some of Hollywood's most powerful, talks about what landed her in rehab.

A friend talks about considering a hit man during her disastrous **Kevin Federline** years.

An investment adviser once involved with her financial affairs says Britney's fortune has been siphoned through questionable transactions and calls her entourage "parasitic leeches intent on sucking her dry."

Due to certain musical handlers' demands, Britney suffered some voice injury. Industry people allege she has at times lip-synched in concert, and record producers are known to work "magic" in the studio.

Tibetan Oracle

My friend ST invited me to a special occasion. It's the first time the Tibetan Oracle has visited Miami. Venerable Thupten Ngodup, Chief Oracle of Tibet. Last night a group gathered in the University of Miami Law School class auditorium to listen, learn, and receive.

A local band "Inner Voice" played a rhythmic song about teachers from our past. That was the initiation into the event.

There were 5 Tibetan monks sitting up front facing the audience. The oracle had a translator there. It was difficult for me to follow the message since it was very start and stop. What stuck in my mind was that he said the blessing we received tonight and the tools we gain are to be a practice. It's not a one time thing. He mentioned that he has repeated his chants over 18 million times. We are to take the blessing and go out and practice compassion everyday.

My friend ST noticed that they talked about spiritual warriors. I honestly didn't hear that part. I was feeling a bit nauseous for awhile. I couldn't tell if it was because I was hungry or the perfumes around me were too much for me. As much as I didn't want to get up while the monks were chanting I felt like I needed to or I would have an accident. Leaving the spot I was in did make me feel much better. I think there was some smells around where I was sitting that I couldn't digest.

When they began chanting the temperature in the room started to change. It went from a typical air conditioned room to a room that felt like it had no ventilation. People started to sweat. There was a woman wanting to take off her shirt in the row in front of us. She was wearing a camisole underneath it but hesitated at dropping her shirt lower than her elbows. I noticed the heat. They opened the doors to the classroom. People were fanning themselves. I didn't really feel hot though. I was still ok.

The blessing we received was a VAJRA KILAYA BLESSING. The blessing is meant to heal and allow for transformation. Remove all negative karma and obstacles of the participants. One by one the monk touched our crown, throat, & heart with a sacred stick. I don't know the name of the stick. It was wrapped on the ends in cloth. A second monk had a small box and he laid it on the top of the heads.

The entire experience was very serene. I felt good and relaxed. Much better than when I arrived which was a little amped.
